Survey Introduction

All actively practicing members of Doctors of BC were invited to participate in this survey, which ran from September 12 to October 11, 2023. The survey was conducted by an external polling firm, TWI Surveys. It was sent to 13,323 members, of which 2,625 physicians responded, resulting in a response rate of 20%. All individual responses and comments are anonymous and confidential.

The survey used 17 questions with a 5-point Likert scale, adopting questions from Health Standards Organization's Physician Work Life Pulse Tool and the Guarding Minds Survey. The analysis is presented in an agree, neutral, disagree format.

The overall data is valid 19 times out of 20 with a margin of error of +/1.57%. All percentages have been rounded to the nearest whole number.

Note from TWI: Due to the implementation of a new data system, the rounding of 2022 scores may differ slightly from last year's report (+1%/-1%).

Sample sizes for the demographic breakdowns are included in some of the charts in this report.








