

How do I become a Board member?

- 1. Members are eligible to be nominated for one of seven Directors-at-Large positions. The other two positions on the Board are: President and President-Elect (both of whom have already been elected).**
- 2. To become a Board member, you must be nominated by a member in good standing which means his/her 2017 membership dues were paid in full by June 25th, 2017. The nomination period runs from July 26th to August 25th, 2017.**

- 4. The Representative Assembly will elect the Board members from the group of nominees at its first meeting on September 14th.**
- 5. The first meeting of the Board will take place September 15th, 2017.**
- 6. Of the seven Board Directors-at-Large positions, one is an annually elected position filled by a physician in a discipline opposite to that of the Incoming President. For the 2017/2018 year, that position will be filled by a Specialist.**
- 7. The Board will meet approximately eight times per year.**
