

How do I vote in upcoming elections?

1. Ensure you are eligible to vote

- a. Only members in good standing (i.e. members who have paid their 2017 membership dues at the time the vote opens) will be eligible to vote.

2. Determine the category(s) in which you are eligible to vote for Representative Assembly (RA) delegate positions

- a. Elected delegates to the RA include:
 - i. District Delegates
 - ii. First Nations Delegates
 - iii. Rural Delegates
- b. To vote for First Nations and Rural delegates, you must have confirmed whether you provide services to the First Nations Health Authority and/or whether you provide rural care within the scope of the [Rural Subsidiary Agreement \(RSA\)](#). Only individuals who provide these services will be eligible to vote for First Nations and Rural delegates to the RA.
- c. You can provide this information either by completing the "Governance Affiliation" section found on your [Member Contact Info](#) page, or when renewing your membership via the membership renewal form or [online renewal](#). The deadline to confirm is April 30, 2017.
- d. All members in good standing are eligible to vote for District Delegates. Your district is determined by the information you provide on your membership form. If you have renewed your membership, you will automatically be eligible to vote for your District Delegate.

3. Voting for President-Elect

- a. All members in good standing are eligible to vote for the President-Elect. If you have renewed your membership, you will automatically be eligible to vote for this position.
